SERVING GREATER BATON ROUGE FOR OVER HALF A CENTURY

Since 1960, Baton Rouge Ballet Theatre (BRBT) has nurtured and trained hundreds of award winning local dancers and choreographers while continuing to bring world-class professional artists to the Baton Rouge stage. Named artistic directors in 1976, Molly Buchmann and Sharon Mathews guided the artistic vision of the organization for over 48 years. Among their many contributions, Molly and Sharon created the BRBT original, *The Nutcracker – A Tale from the Bayou*, in 1992. Since its inception, this treasured production has continued to thrill children and adults alike as one of the most highly anticipated events of the holiday season.

After decades of performances, Molly and Sharon took their final bows in 2024. Today, BRBT is under the direction of co-artistic directors, Rebecca Acosta and Jonna Cox. Both Rebecca and Jonna have introduced innovative programming, including a new full-length production, *Alice in Wonderland*.

Can you imagine a holiday season without the time-honored tradition *The Nutcracker: A Tale from the Bayou?* We can't either.


For the past 65 years, the Baton Rouge Ballet Theatre has continuously delivered high quality performances and programs to Baton Rouge and surrounding communities.



BRBT presents an annual professional performance season that includes outstanding main stage productions at the River Center Theatre for the Performing Arts and other venues in town. Our seasons include hosting a professional ballet touring company, *The Nutcracker – A Tale from the Bayou and* a full-length classical ballet or a mixed bill of contemporary ballet and cutting-edge, modern works.

Youth Ballet

BRBT's Youth Ballet Summer Tour is one of our cornerstone community outreach initiatives that fosters the advancement of classical and contemporary dance. This community outreach program highlights the talents of our younger dancers in a series of performances around the city. As they train and perform together, these young dancers receive valuable professional-caliber training, while also delighting area audiences with their highly anticipated productions. This year, our dancers performed 17 shows and reached over 2,500 kids and adults at libraries, retirement homes, community centers, and other, underserved audiences.

COMMUNITY OUTREACH PROGRAMS

Ballet Experience

With the help of community sponsors, BRBT is able to distribute free main stage performance tickets through local organizations, including Big Buddy, East Baton Rouge Parish Schools, Family & Youth Services, Life of a Single Mom, and Youth Oasis. This program offers free access to community members who may not otherwise have the opportunity to experience the art of ballet in a live performance setting.



Ballet for Every Body

BRBT's Ballet for Every Body program emphasizes that dance is something that all body shapes and sizes can enjoy. Everyone moves differently in dance and through the classic tale of Peter and the Wolf, k-12 students can explore how different styles of movement are all beautiful with the goal of making everyone feel empowered to dance.
